We're also busy making plans to replant our winery estate vineyards with a mix of popular local varieties like Chardonnay, leaving room to experiment with some varieties that are less common to Sonoma Valley, like Malbec, Mourvèdre, and Grenache. I find it exciting that you never quite know how well a variety will do at a certain site until your first harvest.

Our Jack London Vineyard Red Blend continues to receive accolades—it was recently named one of the top 100 wines out of Sonoma County.



This block was fermented separately and aged in French oak barrels for almost 2 years. The finest 16 barrels, selected for their elegance and power, were chosen for this special bottling. TASTING NOTES

This deeply colored wine opens with aromas of ripe black cherry and black plum with elegant ndertones of toffee, allspice and leather. The palate is rich and soft with medium tannins. cherry and currant flavors while hints of Enalish black tea and cinnamon add complexity and depth.

FROM THE WINEMAKER

Our 2018 Pinot Noir wine was sourced from a select block of one of our favorite vineyards in the Sonoma Coast appellation. We chose this vineyard because of the ideal location on a hillside near the banks of the Russian River

and the clonal selection, Pommard clone 115. This makes the perfect combination for the highest quality Pinot Noir grapes. The beautiful and rugged Sonoma Coast appellation embraces Sonoma Country's coastline and encompasses both the Russian River and Carneros appellations. This terroir is uniformly cool due to the influence of the Pacific Ocean and experiences a long growing season with ideal conditions for creating Pinot Noir with concentrated flavors, true varietal character and exceptional quality.

TASTING NOTES

Our Portola Vineyard Chardonnay presents lively aromas of ripe stone fruit and orange blossom with hints of white chocolate and allspice. The wine is full-bodied with a rich mouthfeel and creaminess that was achieved by stirring the less during sur lie aging.

Heavy winter rains recharged the soil after years of drought. A moderate summer made

for a steady growing season, with the $\mbox{\rm Dry}\mbox{\, Creek}$ AVA being slightly cooler than usual. The grapes were hand harvested on September 13th, gently pressed at the winery and the juice was sent to French oak barrels for fermentation. The lees were stirred every other week for 3 months before we allowed the wine to settle. 100% of the barrels went through malolactic fermentation and the wine was aged for 9 mothhs in French oak before racking and bottling.

TASTING NOTES

This elegant Cabernet Sauvignon presents complex aromas of fig, black cherry, roasted shishito peppers with a hint of chocolate mole (or Mexican hot chocolate). The palate has ripe blueberry, currant, cinnamon, some peppery spice, and a cocoa powder textured tannins with a savory bay leaf finish.

FROM THE WINEMAKER

The grapes were hand harvested in the $\mathop{\rm cool}\nolimits$ of early morning October 4th, 2017 allowing us to maintain freshness of the fruit. At the winery, the fruit was destemmed to tank and pumped over twice a day - macerated on the skins for 25 days total until drained, pressed and sent to barrel. After 28 months of barrel aging in 45% new oak, the wine was bottled in August 2020

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of blackcurrant and dried blueberry are combined with subtle notes of spicy dried bay leaf and black pepper. The palate shows great texture with cocoa powder tannin, black plum and caramel fried sage.

FROM THE WINEMAKER

The 2018 vintage was mild and try leading to a more historically average picking date. Much of the Cabernet Sauvignon at Jack London

was picked at the end of October but dry-farming led to concentrated fruit at an earlier date leading to an October 6th pick date. Due to the tannic nature of these grapes, we pressed the wine off the skins after only 13 days instead of the usual 20 days of maceration. The wine aged 17 months in oak barrels (60% new) with the majority of French oak from two coopers Nadalie and Berthomieu.

The 2016 vintage had a dry growing season with a moderate crop load, and the mild temperatures contributed to slow ripening and intense flavor of the grapes. We selected the best lots of Merlot, Zinfandel and Syrah from Jack London ranch to create this captivating blend. The wine was aged in auality barrels for a year and a half to add balance and complexity.
